

Aisle to Isle FAQs

Q – Why should I book my destination wedding through Best Travels in Paradise instead of booking on my own?

A – Because.....

- Kathi has been to the Sandals and Beaches properties.
- it doesn't cost you anything extra to book with Kathi while saving you time, money, and stress.
- she can tell you the pros (and cons) of each property.
- she'll listen to what's important to you and make recommendations accordingly.
- she'll be at the other end of the line if you encounter an issue or need help while travelling or on property.

Q – Do I still get the \$25.00 online booking bonus if I book through Best Travels to Paradise?

A – Yes.

Q - Can I have a true Catholic ceremony at any Sandals or Beaches resort?

A – [Yes you can](#) at either of two locations in Jamaica! [Sandals Montego Bay](#) has a wedding chapel and the overwater chapel at [Sandals Southcoast](#) have been blessed as official Catholic ceremony locations. Other islands and resorts have affiliations with local dioceses for offsite church weddings.

Q – Can I have a Jewish ceremony with Rabbi and huppah?

A – Yes you can on any of three islands – The Bahamas, Jamaica, or Beaches Turks and Caicos.

Q – Can I have a Kosher reception?

A – True Kosher catering is not available on any property. Their kitchens are not equipped for it.

Q – Can we elope while at any Sandals or Beaches resort?

A – Yes you can! Certain residency requirements apply of 48 – 72 hrs. Some islands do not include weekends or holidays in that time. Fees vary by island as do document requirements.

Q – Can I visit a property before I book my destination wedding or other group trip?

A – Yes, you can do a [Test Drive](#)! This must be done BEFORE your group code is requested. You'll get the money back when you book 10+ rooms under your group code.

Q – Can I choose where I want the ceremony and the reception to be?

A – Yes. Each resort books one ceremony per hour so you can choose any location on the property that suits you.

Q – Will we be able to communicate with everyone?

A – Yes, all the Caribbean islands are English speaking.

Q – Can I bring my own photographer and/or videographer?

A – Yes. There's no charge if your pros are part of your group room bookings. There's a \$1,000 charge if they are only there for the day.

Q – Can I have a band or a DJ?

A – You can have any type of entertainment that you'd like including local island entertainment such as fire dances, steel drum bands, reggae bands, calypso bands, and costumed dancers.

Q – What kind of perks do I get for booking my destination wedding at Sandals?

A – The list is long and depends on many factors. Kathi will be happy to go over all of that with you prior to booking.

Q – If I book the wedding at a Sandals Resort can children still attend?

A – Yes. They will be charged a day rate and will be limited to the areas and times of the ceremony and reception only. No wondering the property.

Q – Do all of my guests have to stay at my chosen Sandals or Beaches resort to attend the wedding and the reception?

A – No. While it's better for your guests (and you) if they stay at your chosen property any guest can attend if they pay a wedding day fee in advance. The fee varies by resort and restrictions do apply.

Q – Will Kathi be with us on property?

A – If you want Kathi to travel with you to be the liaison for you and your guests that can be arranged for a small fee + travel expenses. If you need more than Kathi on site there are trained BTTP associates that can travel to your event as well.
